Chairman's Welcome

1. To receive apologies for absence and to note absentees

Apologies had been received from Lord Dear, Paul Shaw, & Tommy Mayne.

2. Welcome – newly elected Council members

BASC Chairman congratulated Mr Christopher Barker on his election onto Council.

Christopher Barker gave an introduction of himself to Council.

BASC Chairman welcomed Mr Christopher Barker to Council.

3. Declaration of Interest

Eoghan Cameron, item 4, Claire Sadler, item 5 and Oliver McCullough 6, and Robin Marshall-Ball and Paul Shaw who is not present declared an interest in the Awards Committee under AOB.

B. ISSUES FOR DEBATE AND DECISION

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BASC Chairman handed the Chair to the CEO. The CEO outlined the election process and reminded Council of the confidential nature of the elections. He highlighted that, as there are only single candidates for each of the positions, candidates can be elected by acclamation. Should there be objections to election by acclamation then a vote will be taken.

The CEO confirmed that the AGM has approved our change in Constitution related to tenure of office holders.

The CEO also stated that he will raise the Honours and Awards under AOB.

4. Election of BASC Chairman

The CEO confirmed there had been one candidate, Eoghan Cameron for election of the role of BASC Chairman. There were no objections and Eoghan Cameron was duly appointed as BASC Chairman.

The CEO and Council congratulated Eoghan Cameron for his re-election as BASC Chairman.

5. Election of BASC Vice-Chair

6. Election of Chairman of Executive and Finance Committee

7. Motions for co-option

BASC Chairman referred the two candidates for co-option onto Council:

- Ian Coghill

Director Wales gave an overview of Richard Garner Williams who is born in North Wales. Director Wales invited Richard Garner Williams to be part of the Wales Committee three years ago and will stand next year for the Wales Election seat.

BASC Chairman stated that he had met with Steve Griffiths and Richard Garner Williams last week and that he supports the recommendation for the co-option of Richard Garner Williams onto Council.

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There were no questions from Council.

BASC Chairman asked for a show of hands to support this recommendation.

There were 10 Council votes in favour; Richard Garner Williams is co-opted onto Council.

BASC E&F Chairman and Ian Grindy proposed and seconded the co-option of Ian Coghill and delivered short supporting statements.

There were 10 Council votes in favour; Ian Coghill was co-opted onto Council.

8. AOB

Therefore, it is noted that Robin Marshal-Ball is duly elected as the Honours and Awards Committee Chairman.

BASC E&F Chairman advised Council that he would like to welcome anyone from Council who would like to show an interest in attending the E&F Committee meetings, the E&F Chairman also stated that any existing members who wish to stay on the Committee to enable the Committee to retain the expertise and succession planning would also be welcomed.

BASC E&F Chairman stated that if anyone is interested to contact him directly.

BASC Chairman advised Council that he would encourage anyone to attend at least one E&F meeting.
