



Summary of decisions taken at the Council meeting on Thursday 6th May 2004

Council agreed:

- To “colour code” paperwork to highlight issues for debate and decision
 - To discuss the appointment of a new trustee to the Wildlife Habitat Trust
 - That a Memorandum of Understanding with the Countryside Alliance was not the way forward.
 - That senior BASC executives should work with CA executives to examine ways in which the existing structures can be strengthened to ensure co-operation.
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- Council considered Codes of Practice on Shotgun Safety, Airguns and Respect for Quarry.
 - The Chairman commented on his year in office and BASC’s future. He suggested that Council should consider strengthening BASC’s political and media capacity.
 - Council discussed Defra’s review of general licences
 - Council considered the minutes from the advisory Committees
 - Council received presentations on crisis management and BASC and celebrities.
 - Council received a report on the success of BASC’s fundraising programme
 - Council considered and approved the BASC honours and awards for 2004
 - Council discussed the motions for debate at the AGM.
