



Summary of decision taken at the Council meeting on Thursday 25th November 2004

Council agreed:

- That Advisory Committee Chairmen should liaise with secretaries to establish an agreed budget with justification for expenditure.
- The 2005 budget.
- That the draft terrier code should be put forward to Defra.
- That Vivienne Jasper be appointed IPS Secretary for BASC from January 1st 2005.
- To conduct more fox shooting trials using smaller loads and that results so far should be peer reviewed.
- To support initiatives to ensure that game meat could be described as natural and from "wild" animals.

- Council received a verbal update on the development at BASC Scotland office at Trochry.
- Council reviewed BASC's 5 year plan.
- Council received a presentation on the completed BASC fox shooting study
- Council discussed a paper on the reform of BASC Council
- Council discussed a paper on the future development and direction of BASC
- Council considered two papers on the impact on shooting of wind farms and coastal erosion.
- Council discussed Tower Hamlets Borough Council's decision to ban the keeping of legal firearms in police approved storage in Council properties.
