

Summary of decisions taken at the Council meeting on Thursday 17th February 2005

Council agreed:

- To begin a process to allow other organisations concerned with shooting and conservation to have a closer relationship with BASC by inviting representatives to attend a meeting of Council.
- To establish a register of interests and that a declaration of interests should be asked for at the start of each meeting.
- The BASC code of practice for the use of a dog underground.
- Council approved the arrangements for conducting the ballot for elections to Council.
- Council discussed motions coming before the next AGM.
- Council requested a scoping paper on a new Communications centre.
- Council received a report on the positive response from Members and others to Council's statement on battery-type cage laying systems.
- Council received an update on the redevelopment of the Scottish centre at Trochry.
